I-istituzzjonijiet Ewropej jehtigilhom jirrikonoxxu, jinvolve u jappoġġjaw lis-soċjetà ċivili bħala parti minn djalogu ċivili strutturat

Il-firmatarji ta' din l-ittra jappellaw lill-istituzzjonijiet Ewropej biex jiehdu **mizuri reali biex jimplimentaw id-dispożizzjonijiet tat-Trattat dwar djalogu miftuħ, trasparenti u regolari mas-soċjetà ċivili fl-oqsma kollha ta' politika.**

Il-firmatarji jappellaw lill-istituzzjonijiet tal-UE biex:

1. iniedu ftehim interistituzzjonali dwar id-djalogu ċivili,
2. jistabbilixxu fi ħdan kull istituzzjoni pożizzjonijiet ta' tmexxija li jkunu responsabbli għar-relazzjonijiet mas-soċjetà ċivili, u
3. iħeġġu u jippromovu kooperazzjoni ikbar bejn l-atturi ċiviċi u soċjali.

Bħala parti mill-prinċipji demokratiċi tal-UE minquxa fit-

Trattati, l-Artikolu 11 tat-Trattat dwar l-Unjoni Ewropea jitlob lill-istituzzjonijiet tal-UE jżommu djalogu miftuħ, trasparenti u regolari mal-assocjazzjonijiet rappreżentattivi u mas-soċjetà ċivili. Madankollu, minkejja dawn id-dispożizzjonijiet legali, id-djalogu ċivili għadu frammentat u mhux strutturat fl-istituzzjonijiet tal-UE. Id-djalogu ċivili ħafna drabi gie organizzat fuq bażi purament ad hoc u jvarja ħafna f'termini ta' kwantità u kwalità, skont il-qasam ta' politika, l-istituzzjoni Ewropea jew l-Istat Membru.

Reġghet ingibdet l-attenzjoni ta' dawk li jfasslu l-politika għall-valur tad-djalogu ċivili meta dan gie **rikonoxxut mill-Plenarja tal-Konferenza dwar il-Futur tal-Ewropa**, li fiha pparteċipaw membri tal-pubbliku, rappreżentanti tal-istituzzjonijiet tal-UE u korpi konsultattivi, rappreżentanti eletti fil-livelli nazzjonali,

reġjonali u lokali u s-soċjetà ċivili organizzata. Ir-rapport finali tal-Konferenza, ippubblikat f'Mejju 2022, heġġeġ għal *"... riforma tal-mod kif topera l-Unjoni Ewropea billi jiġu involuti aħjar l-imsieħba soċjali u s-soċjetà ċivili organizzata. It-tiŝiħ tal-istrutturi eżistenti sabiex jiġu riflessi aħjar il-ħtiġijiet u l-aspettattivi taċ-ċittadini tal-UE fil-proċess tat-teħid tad-deċiżjonijiet ..."* (Proposta Nru 39 fil-kapitolu dwar id-demokrazija Ewropea). Infakkru wkoll fil-Proposta Nru 36, li l-oġettiv tagħha huwa li *"jiżdiedu l-partecipazzjoni taċ-ċittadini u l-involvement taż-żgħażaġħ",* fost affarijiet oħra billi *"tissahhaħ il-kooperazzjoni bejn il-leġiżlaturi tal-UE u l-organizzazzjonijiet tas-soċjetà ċivili biex isir użu mir-rabtiet bejn dawk li jieħdu d-deċiżjonijiet u ċ-ċittadini li jikkostitwixxu l-organizzazzjonijiet tas-soċjetà ċivili".*

Il-firmatarji ta' din l-ittra b'dan iheggu li dawn ir-rakkomandazzjonijiet jiġu segwiti b'approċċ ambizzjuż. Huma konvinti ferm li l-isfruttar sħiħ tal-potenzjal tal-involvement tal-organizzazzjonijiet tas-soċjetà ċivili fit-tfassil tal-politika se jirrikjedi approċċ aktar strutturat fil-livell tal-UE.¹

Għalhekk, huma jistiednu b'mod kongunt lill-istituzzjonijiet Ewropej biex:

1. **Iniedu ftehim interistituzzjonali dwar id-djalogu ċivili²,** li jipprovdi struttura, regolarità, trasparenza u inkluzività għad-djalogu ċivili fit-tfassil tal-politika tal-UE u nazzjonali bħala parti mill-implimentazzjoni sħiħa tal-Artikolu 11(1) u (2)³ tat-Trattat dwar l-Unjoni Ewropea⁴.
2. **F'dan il-qafas, jistabbilixxu l-kariga ta' "Koordinatur tas-Sočjetà Ċivili"** f'kull Direttorat Ġenerali tal-Kummissjoni Ewropea, simili għall-kariga proposta ta' "Koordinatur tad-Djalogu Soċjali". Barra minn hekk, l-istituzzjonijiet tal-UE għandhom jistabbilixxu pożizzjonijiet ta' tmexxija li jkunu responsabbli għar-relazzjonijiet mas-soċjetà ċivili. **Viċi President tal-Kummissjoni Ewropea** għandu jassumi l-kompitu ta' djalogu mas-soċjetà ċivili u r-rwol tal-**Viċi President tal-Parlament Ewropew inkarigat mill-kuntatti mas-soċjetà ċivili** għandu jissahhaħ. Is-Segretarjat tal-Kunsill u, fil-livell nazzjonali, l-Uffiċċji tal-Parlament Ewropew u tal-Kummissjoni għandhom jistabbilixxu wkoll djalogu regolari mas-soċjetà ċivili. L-introduzzjoni

ta' mezzi diretti għall-organizzazzjonijiet tas-soċjetà ċivili biex jinvolvu ruħhom fil-proċess tat-tfassil tal-politika tal-UE tista' twassal għal politiki aktar immirati u effettivi fl-oqsma u l-kwistjonijiet soċjoekonomiċi kollha.

3. Il-firmatarji jirrispettaw bis-sħiħ il-prerogattivi tal-imsieħba soċjali fid-djalogu soċjali, in-negożjati tripartitiċi u n-negożjar kollettivi. Fl-istess ħin, il-partijiet ikkonċernati tas-soċjetà ċivili għandhom għarfien, għarfien espert u networks estensivi fil-komunitajiet u s-soċjetajiet, għalhekk il-firmatarji jemmnu li l-atturi tas-soċjetà ċivili għandhom isemmgħu leħinhom meta jkun adatt. Wara kollox, l-organizzazzjonijiet tas-soċjetà ċivili li jkunu effettivi u responsabbli jistgħu jikkooperaw mal-gvernijiet, l-organizzazzjonijiet ta' min iħaddem u tal-ħaddiema fil-promozzjoni tad-drittijiet fuq il-post tax-xogħol, l-inkoraġġiment tal-ħolqien tal-impjegi, l-implimentazzjoni tat-tranżizzjoni doppja ekoloġika u diġitali u t-tiŝiħ tal-protezzjoni soċjali.

L-istituzzjonijiet Ewropej għandhom l-għodod kollha meħtieġa għad-dispożizzjoni tagħhom biex jimpennjaw ruħhom fir-rigward ta' dawn il-proposti u jagħmlu progress konsiderevoli fuqhom qabel l-elezzjonijiet Ewropej fl-2024. L-ewwel pass f'din id-direzzjoni jista' jkun **Komunikazzjoni tal-Kummissjoni Ewropea dwar it-tiŝiħ tad-djalogu ċivili fil-livell tal-UE u Proposta għal Rakkomandazzjoni dwar il-promozzjoni tad-djalogu ċivili** fl-Istati Membri, **simili għall-inizjattiva dwar it-Tiŝiħ tad-djalogu soċjali⁵,** u li tagħti segwitu għar-Rapport Annwali dwar l-Applikazzjoni tal-Karta tad-Drittijiet Fundamentali⁶. Dan ikun konformi wkoll mas-sejha għal Strategija għas-Sočjetà Ċivili⁷.

Il-firmatarji ta' din l-ittra jinsabu lesti li jaħdmu fi sħubija mal-istituzzjonijiet sabiex jiddefinixxu l-elementi kostitwenti u r-rekwiżiti ewlenin biex dawn il-proposti jiġu implimentati fil-prattika.
