...in a nutshell





Building local cooperations in the Baltic Sea Region (BSR) to address the challenge of food waste in schools

Following a multi-stakeholder approach, FoodLoops aims to:

- Understand the barriers of each target group in regards to food waste in the school scenario in the three partner countries: FI, PL and LT
- Empower better bio-waste separation at source
- Facilitate valorization of unavoidable food waste by turning it into products of value, such as compost, that helps close the resource loop
