
SUSTAINABLE GALS



SDG 12.3: By 2030, halve per capita global food waste at the retail and consumer levels and reduce food losses along production and supply chains, including post-harvest losses.










Latest data on food waste (source: Eurostat 2021)



Food waste in the EU: key numbers and impacts



- 16% of total GHG from EU food system (254 million tonnes of CO₂)
- 132 bn EUR in associated market value; 9.3 bn EUR for waste collection and treatment
- Unnecessary spending: 4-person household could save about 400 EUR/year
- Ethical dimension: over 37 million EU citizens cannot afford a high-quality meal every second day



EU food waste reduction targets



Legislative proposal adopted by the Commission on 05 July 2023

Part of the <u>revision of the Waste</u>

<u>Framework Directive</u> (+textile waste)


The proposal:

- establishes target levels
- includes a revision clause
- requires actions by countries

On-going negotiations with the European Parliament and the Council of the EU

Food waste prevention: building on the EU toolbox

- <u>Legal obligations</u> for Member States to reduce, measure and monitor food waste
- Common <u>EU methodology</u> to measure food waste consistently
- <u>EU Platform</u> on Food Losses and Food Waste
- Facilitate food donation
 - <u>EU food donation guidelines</u>
- Optimise safe use of food in feed
 - <u>EU guidelines on feed use of food no longer intended for human consumption</u>
- Promote better understanding and use of <u>date</u> marking
