





The Charter needs to attach itself to the Shark It always needs a hook



- RoL reports
- EU laws and EU judgments

#### MONITORING

Systemic monitoring and follow up

#### SYSTEMIC INFRINGMENT PROCEEDINGS

- Spotlight on rights based cases
- Transparency in proceedings
- Possibility for amicus briefs
- Expedited procedure and interim measures

#### IMPLEMENTATION OF JUDGMENTS

- Monitoring unit
- Procedure similar to Rule 9 procedure
- Expedited referral back to the court
