- Research and studies to gather a better understanding of children and youth interests




BJV - How we work

Youth Check in Austria

- ➤Implemented since 2013
- Legislative proposals should take into account the effects on "Children and Youth"
- ➤ Young people's concerns should be a part of the legislation process (in all areas)



PROs

- >awareness for youth concerns rises
- >cross-sectional approach to youth topics youth mainstreaming
- Fiscal, energy and environmental policy specifically pointed out





CONs

➤Often not enough knowledge on youth in various ministries

- Should not and cannot replace real participation of young people
- ➤ Is often applied too late in legislation process
- ➤ Danger of "box-ticking-exercise"
