At the end of the project, a synthesis report will present the project's main findings, conclusions and recommendations. The six fact-finding missions will take place in six Member States that were also visited in 2015-2016, namely Italy, Greece, Malta and Bulgaria as countries of arrival or transit and Sweden and Germany as countries of destination. It would be useful to include as many IMI Group members as possible, while also trying to have a member from the country to be visited.
