The just transition should simultaneously reduce environmental degradations and reduce existing inequalities, while guaranteeing access to fundamental rights for all	The just transition should first focus on workers-related issues and should aim at guaranteeing the perspectives of workers and their access to decent and quality jobs as part of the ecological transition.	The action of the state (taxation, investment and social security) is key in ensuring a just transition. The ecological crises and environmental degradation should be seen as social risks to be mutualized	The just transition should ensure as a "level-playing field" for companies and should aim at guaranteeing the security of supply of energy and materials.

1) Conceptual origins


- * The concept of a just transition originated from the U.S. labor movement. In the early 1990s, Tony Mazzocchi, leader of the Oil, Chemical, and Atomic Workers Union, proposed the idea of a 'Superfund for Workers', referencing the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's recently-established Superfund program for toxic cleanups.

- * Preamble to the Paris Agreement (2015): « Taking into account the imperatives of a just transition for the workforce and the creation of decent and quality jobs in accordance with nationally determined development priorities»

European Union - Just Transition Mechanism

→ Linked to DG REGIO and FEDER Funds

Just Transition Fund

- of €19.2 billion in current prices, is expected to mobilise around EUR €25.4 billion in investments.
- Territorial plans, social dialogue, local needs.
- Aims to support the phasing out of fossil fuels in regions heavily dependent on them (mainly in Eastern Europe)

InvestEU "Just Transition" scheme

• Provide a budgetary guarantee under the InvestEU programme across the four policy windows and an InvestEU Advisory Hub that act as a central entry point for advisory support requests. It is expected to mobilise €10-15 billion in mostly private sector investments.

Public Sector Loan Facility

 Combine €1.5 billion of grants financed from the EU budget with €10 billion of loans from the European Investment Bank, to mobilise €18.5 billion of public investment.

EU BE Presidency : priority 'Just Transition' (1/6) Objectives

Organize exchanges and knowledge building on just transition at European level in cooperation with European civil society organisations, administrations, citizens and political representatives.

Use the momentum that exists regarding just transition in Belgium and Europe to formulate a number of important signals and concrete proposals to the next European Commission, the new European Parliament and national governments about possible policy initiatives or reforms that should contribute to the ecological transition of the European economy and society leaves no one behind.

The insights gained during the Spanish presidency and during the States General and the Conference in **Belgium**, which are relevant for the European level, can also be raised at this level.

Following the example of the Sibiu Declaration, we want to obtain a mention of the importance of a just transition in **a 'joint statement' by government leaders**.

EU BE Presidency: priority 'Just Transition' (3/6) Request for an opinion from the EESC

- European Economic and Social Committee
 - A European advisory council composed of Employers, trade unionists and representatives of social, occupational, economic and cultural organizations
- "We would appreciate an opinion on the steps the EU should take to establish a comprehensive just transition policy framework. This framework should be capable of fostering a carbon-neutral, environmentally sustainable, non-toxic, and fully circular society and economy by 2050, without further jeopardising the socio-economic opportunities of vulnerable regions and people."

Program preparation

- July 11: Just Transition conference in Valladolid (after informal ENVI council)
 - => organized by Solidar (European and worldwide network of Civil Society Organisations working to advance social justice through a just transition in Europe and worldwide)
 - => Hosted by Minister Teresa Ribera
 - => Minister Zakia Khattabi has been formally invited
- September 20: presentation at the European Alliance for a Just Transition members meeting
 - => The alliance is a group of civil society, social and environmental movements, and political parties to unite behind a call for immediate, bold, and transformative action at all levels of society to build a sustainable and safe future for all
 - => They approached us and asked for a presentation of the priority Just Transition during our presidency

EU BE Presidency : priority 'Just Transition' (4/6) Program preparation in 2023, inter alia ...

"Many European citizens still do not feel that the ecological transition in the EU is being organized in a fair way. A 2022 Eurobarometer survey on perceptions of the green transition shows that only 50% of respondents think the EU is doing enough for a just transition and only 46% of respondents are confident that sustainable energy, products and services will be affordable for everyone, including poorer people, by 2050."
