

Many young people face uncertainty in identifying their role within this landscape.




INCLUSIVITY




Presentation of a diversified value chain, that englobes different streams and categories.



Highlight the skills from real workers and relative jobs among the value chain.





Next Steps




STUDENT ENERGY SUMMIT

Role of the EU Commission and how the ETCC can help





The European Commission can:


- Facilitate industry-student collaboration to align skills with the energy sector's needs.
- 2. Develop and support green technology and sustainable energy **training programs**.
- 3. Promote **reskilling and upskilling** initiatives
- 4. Promote **Flexible academic curriculum** to accommodate people from different backgrounds and responsibilities (young people from families with less financial capabilities, young parents, etc).

How to attract best talents in the energy sector and to share experiences through research and innovation activities?

- 1. Strengthen **academia-industry alliance s** and foster **joint research programs** to bridge the divide.
- 2. Nurture an **innovation-centric culture** and ensure s**kill development** amid the constant evolution of the sector.
- 3. Ensure **financial support** mechanisms such as scholarships and research grants for students
- Create programs for experienced professionals to become ambassadors of this sector and by sharing their experience.

How to ensure the development of necessary knowledge and competencies, especially in the field of green skills and training?

- 1. Raise **awareness** within youth about the green transition career opportunities.
- **2. Educate and guide** individuals not yet in the labor force about green jobs
- Collaborate with industry stakeholders to determine in-demand green skills and competencies, and adapt training programs.
- 4. Promote, fund and support different **Green Skills Assessment Tools**, making sure
 everyone can decide on their future career with
 all the information within their reach.
