Since 2009, Sorin Onișor has given photography workshops in his own country and abroad. Being a founding member of the photographic group entitled "F5,6", based in Timișoara, he is also an author and has co-written two books.

His work has met with a high level of recognition and he has been awarded some prominent prizes, such as the First Prize for Photojournalism and Photographer of the Year at the AAFFR Salon in 2010. He has also been a member of various specialised panels for national photography contests.

Born in Timișoara in 1970, he has a Bachelor's degree in History, a Master's degree in "Oriental Romania" and a Degree in Photography from the Folk Art School, Timișoara.

Sorin Onișor is one of the most well-known Romanian photographers in his country. Often called "**the Romanian village photographer**", he inspires many young people and his photographs of Romanian landscapes and countryside life are highly appreciated.

"I have always been connected to the Romanian village... I could have chosen other branches of this art, but my calling has always been the world of the Romanian village and that has influenced all the stages of my life", mentions Sorin in one of his interviews.

His heart is undoubtedly won over by the world of pastoral Romania. From Maramureş to the Danube Delta, from Banat to Moldavia, Sorin is constantly searching those remote places, stunning landscapes and people as yet untouched by time.

Sorin Onișor represents a benchmark for photo-journalism. His particular approach has influenced a lot of contemporary photographers in Romania, his dramatic landscapes and poetic portraits bring a renewing breeze, a new style to Romanian photography.

"Sorin Onișor teaches us about light, colours, emotions and soul through images just like Rembrandt or Leonardo da Vinci did with their painting techniques" says Sebastian Vasiu, editor of 1x.com magazine.

For more than 12 years, Sorin Onișor has been wandering through the different regions of Romania. He has crossed the country, from scattered mountain villages to hilly regions and the Danube Delta settlements, capturing in his photos the magic of Romanian landscapes and traditions.

There have been more than 50 exhibitions of Sorin Onisor's work around the world, most recently in Ukraine, Lithuania, Denmark, Belgium, Romania, Finland and the Netherlands. After the exhibition at the EESC, his photographs will be exhibited in China and the USA.
