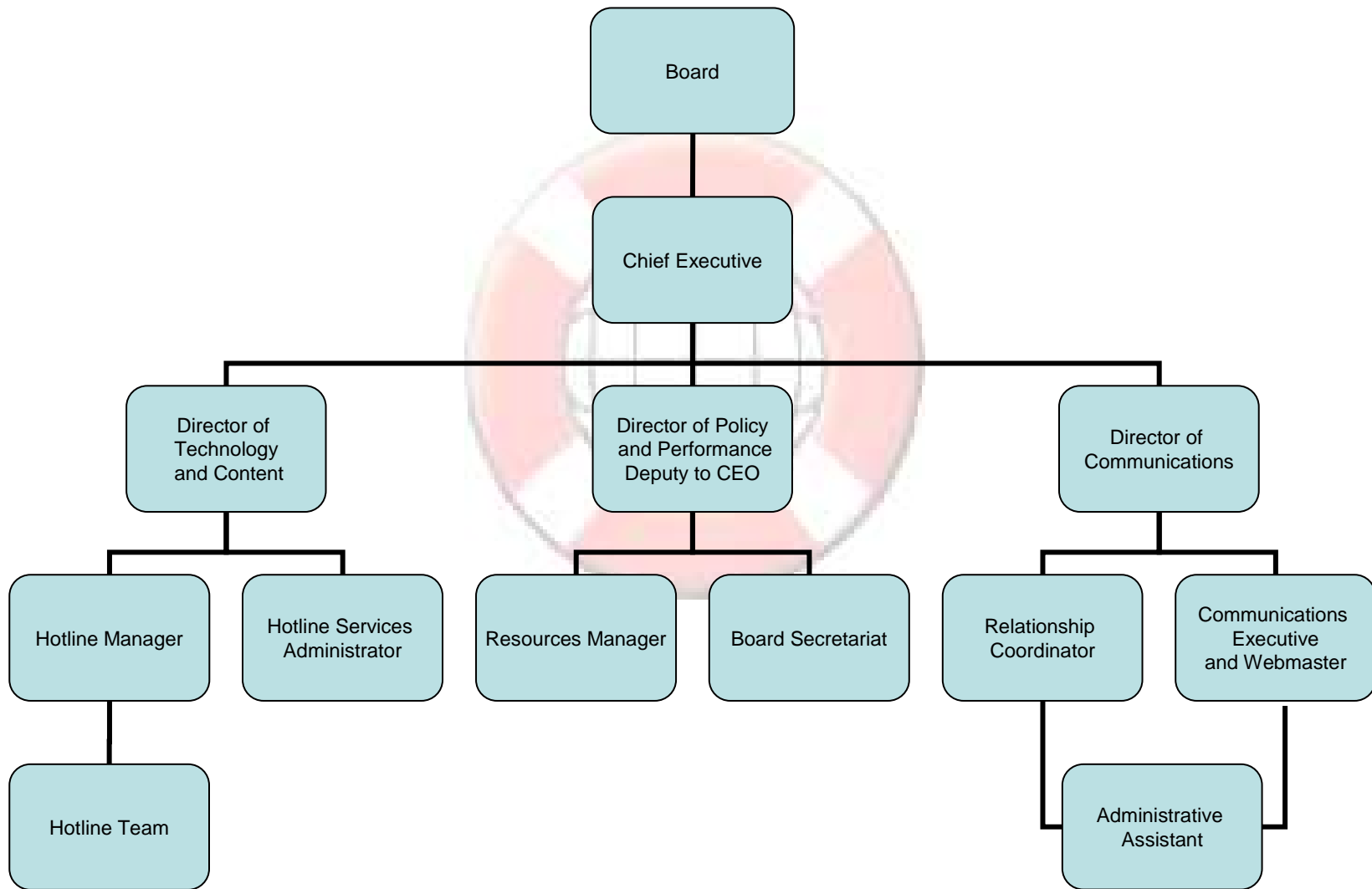

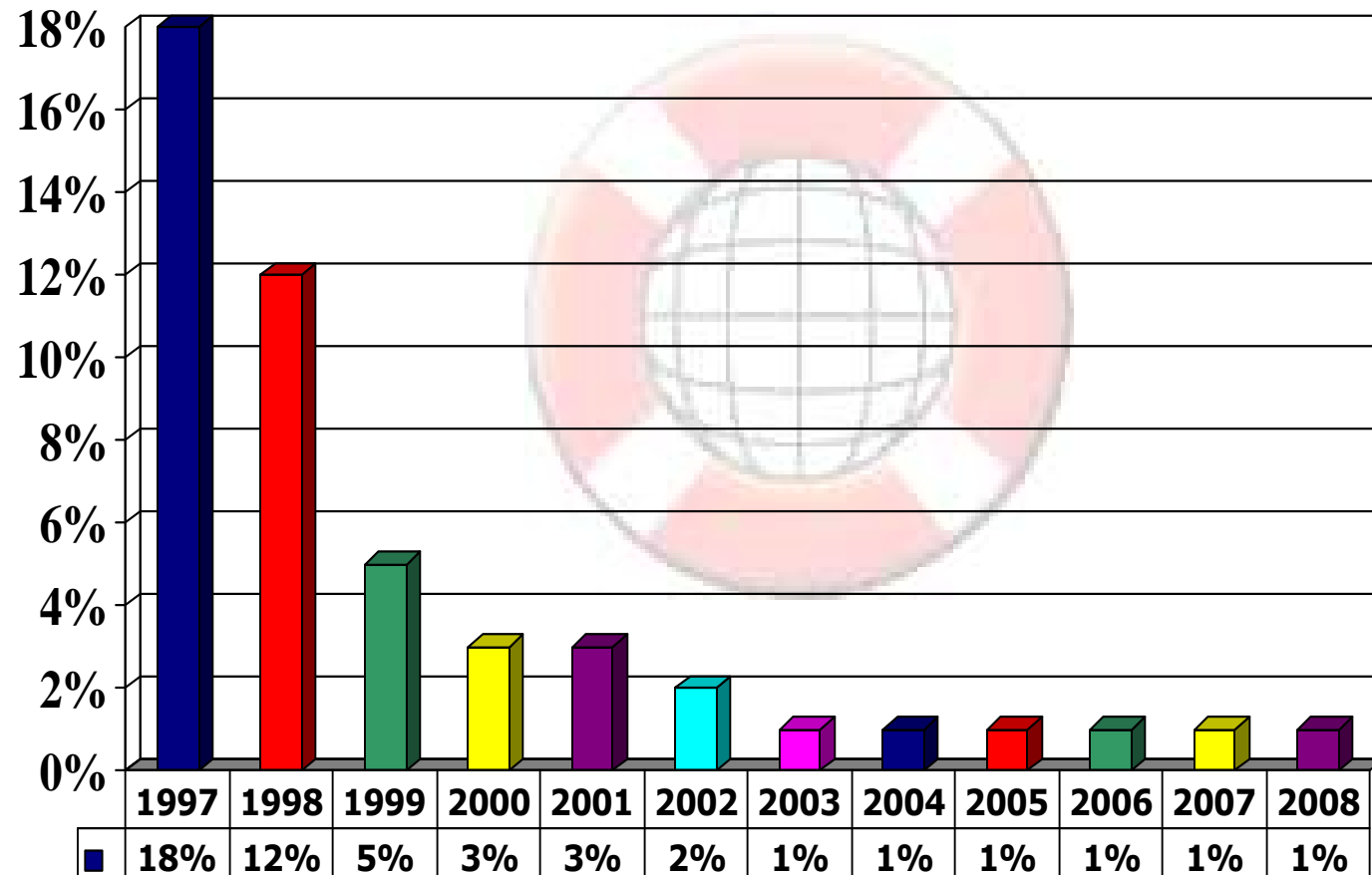
IWF Model

- Content not suspects


