Recipients of the personal data	 Relevant staff of the European Economic and Social Committee (all data collected) Akio SAS, the contractor assisting in the media monitoring (all data collected)
Transfers of personal data to a third country or an international organization	No
Retention period of the personal data	The data will be retained only for the time needed to fulfil the intended objectives (for example statistics) and for a maximum period of 5 years (the duration of the mandate).
	Data relating to financial transactions (the contract with the processor) are retained for a period of 5 years following the discharge of the financial exercise. The discharge of the financial exercise generally takes place 2 years after the financial year, meaning a total of 7 years for holding the personal data or until the end of a possible audit if it started before the end of the above period.
	Data will be automatically removed at the end of the respective period or when no longer needed.
General description of security measures, where possible	Data will be provided only to the contractor and saved in the secure place
